The statistics presented in the 3rd quarter report account for all incidents reported to York University Security Services between November 1, 2014 and January 31, 2015 which occurred on or in relation to the Keele or Glendon Campuses.

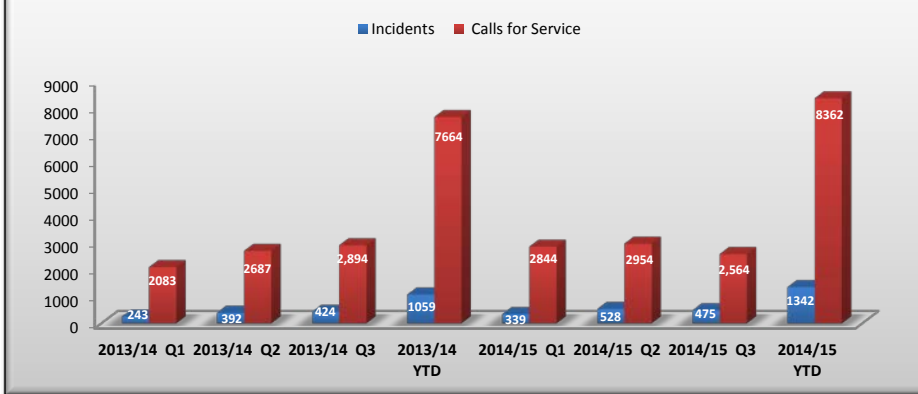
Incidents:

The number of incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 12% to 475 incidents compared to 424 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014. The total number of incidents reported in 2014-2015 Year to Date (YTD) increased by 27% to 1,342 incidents compared to 1,059 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014.

Calls for Service:

The number of calls for service received in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 decreased by 11% to 2,564 compared to 2,894 calls for service received in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014. The total number of calls for service received in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 9% to 8,362 compared to 7,664 calls for service received during the same period in 2013-2014.

The top five incident categories reported accounted for 273 incidents or 57% of the total incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015. The top five incident categories are ranked as per the following:

Emergency Medical

The number of Emergency Medical incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 decreased by 12% to 82 incidents compared to 93 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014. The total number of Emergency Medical incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 6% to 251 incidents compared to 236 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014.

Theft Under \$5000 - Private Property

The number of Theft Under \$5000 – Private Property incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 18% to 65 incidents compared to 55 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014.

The total number of Theft Under \$5000 – Private Property incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 13% to 153 incidents compared to 135 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014.

Fire Alarms

The number of Fire Alarm incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 decreased by 29% to 59 incidents compared to 83 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014.

The total number of Fire Alarm incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by less than 1% to 151 incidents compared to 150 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014.

Mischief Under \$5000 - University Property

The number of Mischief Under \$5000 – University Property incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 46% to 35 incidents compared to 24 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014.

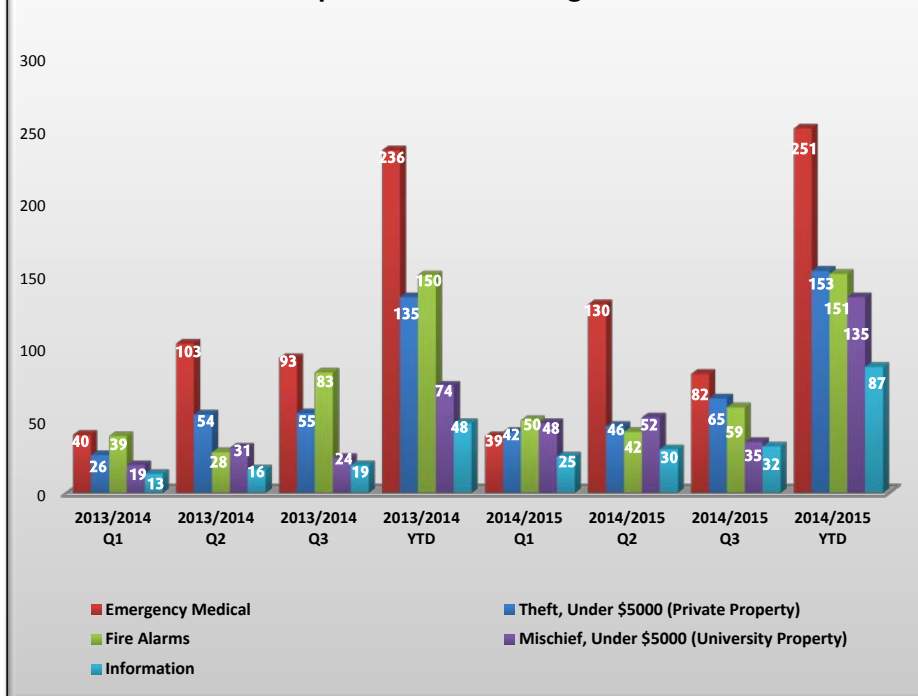
The total number of Mischief Under \$5000 – University Property incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 82% to 135 incidents compared to 74 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014.

Information

The number of Information incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 68% to 32 incidents compared to 19 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014.

The total number of Information incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 81% to 87 incidents compared to 48 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014.

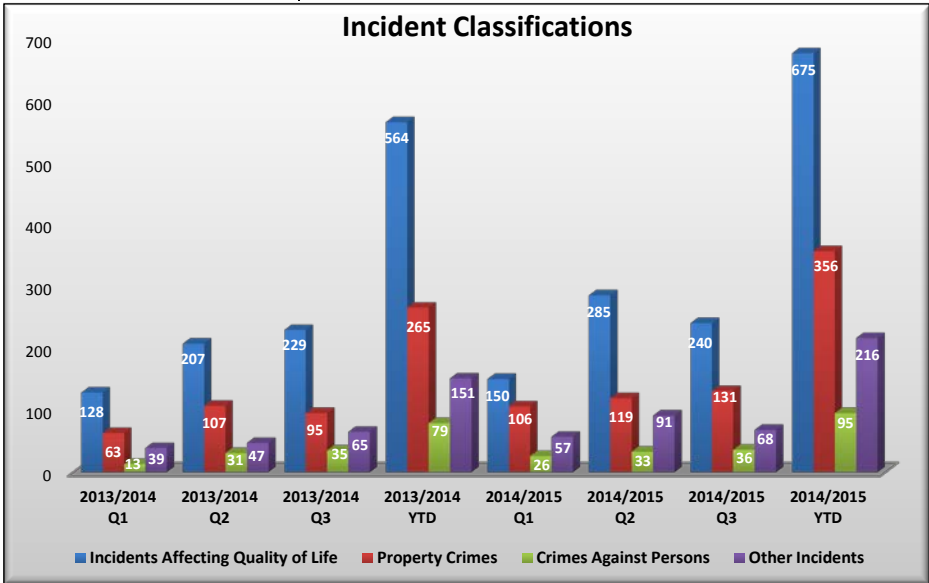
All incidents presented in this report have been categorized as part of an incident classification hierarchy. The incident classifications are as follows:

Incidents Affecting Quality of Life
 The number of Incidents Affecting Quality of Life reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 5% to 240 incidents compared to 229 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014
 The total number of Incidents Affecting Quality of Life reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 20% to 675 incidents compared to 564 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014

Property Crimes
 The number of Property Crime incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 38% to 131 incidents compared to 95 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014
 The total number of Property Crime incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 34% to 356 incidents compared to 265 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014

Crimes Against Persons
 The number of Crimes Against Persons incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 3% to 36 incidents compared to 35 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014
 The total number of Crimes Against Persons incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 20% to 95 incidents compared to 79 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014

Other Incidents
 The number of Other Incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 increased by 5% to 68 incidents compared to 65 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014
 The total number of Other Incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 43% to 216 incidents compared to 151 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014

The following incident categories have been selected as a measure of violent crimes that have been reported to York University Security Services:

Non-Sexual Assault
 The number of Non-Sexual Assault incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 decreased by 58% to 5 incidents compared to 12 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014
 The total number of Non-Sexual Assault incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD decreased by 11% to 17 incidents compared to 19 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014

Sexual Assault
 The number of Sexual Assault incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 decreased by 40% to 3 incidents compared to 5 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014*
 The total number of Sexual Assault incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD decreased by 20% to 8 incidents compared to 10 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014

Robbery
 The number of Robbery incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2014-2015 remained unchanged at 3 incidents compared to 3 incidents reported in the 3rd quarter of 2013-2014
 The total number of Robbery incidents reported in 2014-2015 YTD increased by 50% to 9 incidents compared to 6 incidents reported during the same period in 2013-2014*

* Small number changes equal significant percentage change increases/decreases which could be misleading therefore the absolute number change should be considered.
